Definition

ORIGINAL sentence or example (from your head, not online or someone else).

Word

Image that represents the word/definition. Can be your own OR one found online.

Definition in your own words **OR** a synonym/antonym for the word.

Examining parts to understand how they work together to create meaning as a whole.

Analyze

A principal character or force in opposition to a protagonist, or main character.

The method(s) a writer uses to create and develop characters.

A character with multiple or conflicting motivations; who shows different sides

Complex
Character

A struggle against an outside force,
which may be another character,
society, or nature.

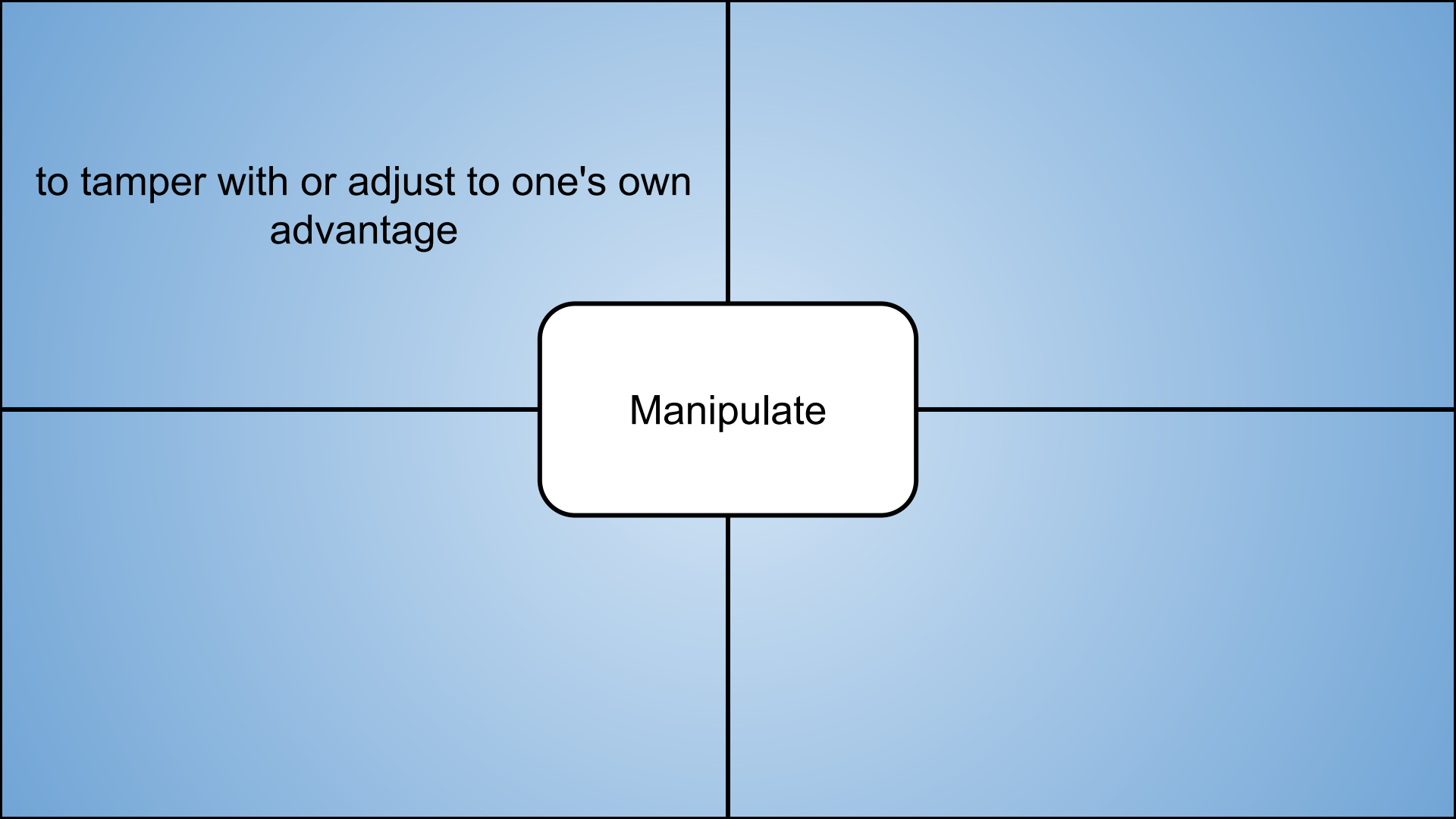
External Conflict
